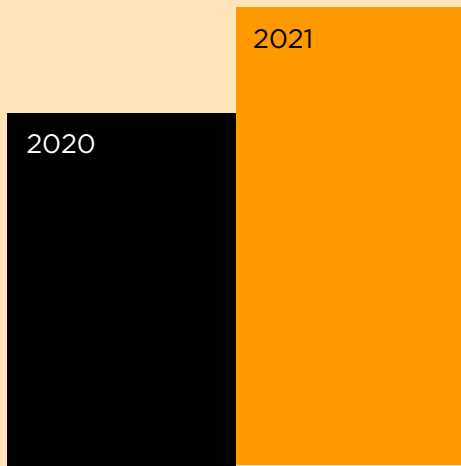


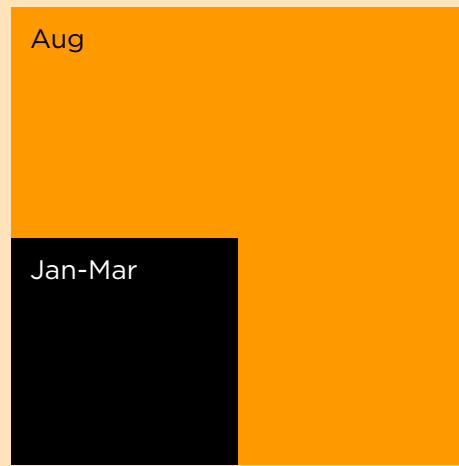

The Great Resignation Shows No Signs of Slowing

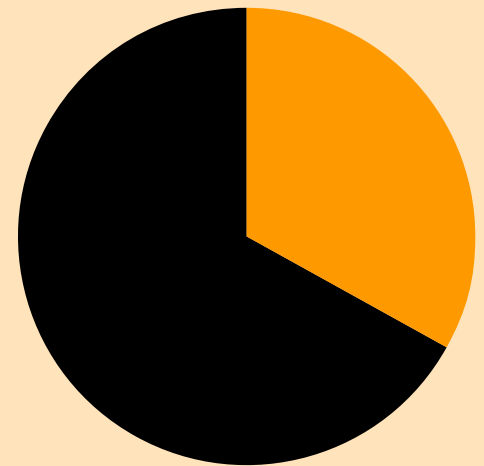
Why? Employees are seeking better working conditions, increased stability, and greater personal freedom.

1 million open jobs in the United Kingdom in August 2021²



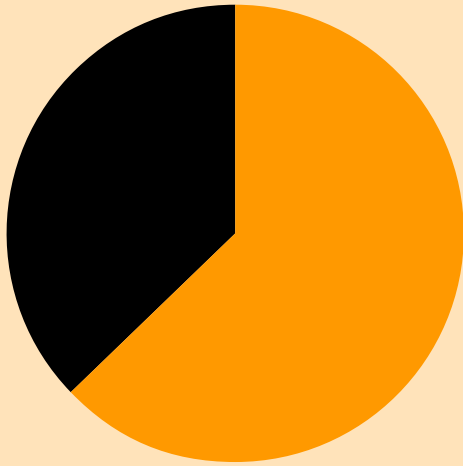
1/3 of all German companies reported a lack of skilled workers³

Increased competition, labor shortages, and changing customer expectations are forcing organizations to rethink their business plans.

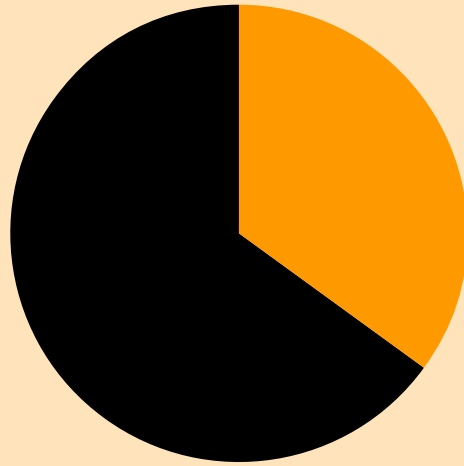
In a time when employees are resigning in droves, investing in employees to ensure they have a meaningful, engaging work experience has become a competitive differentiator.

Your Workforce and Automation

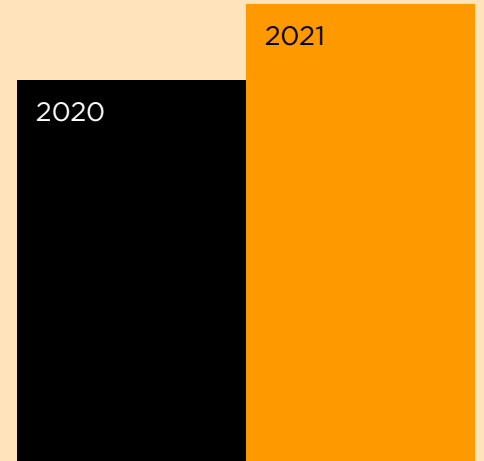
Automation capabilities such as intelligent document processing (IDP) enhance the customer experience and enable your workforce to do their jobs better. Automation is finally scalable.

35% of millennials believe humans and machines can work together ⁵

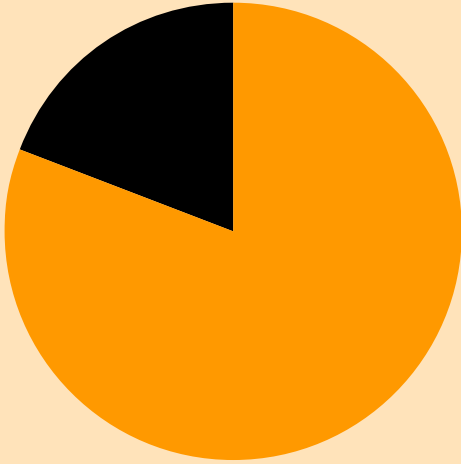


30-45 year olds had the greatest increase in resignation rates in 2021 ⁶

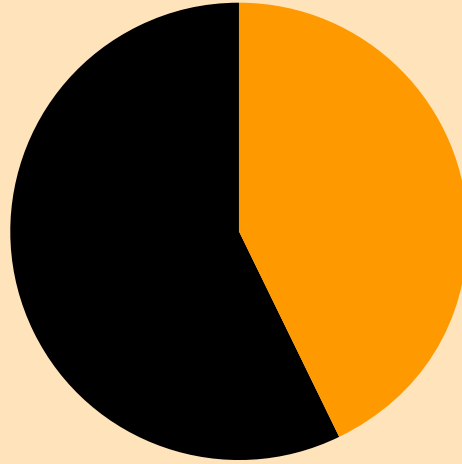


Future-facing Companies are Investing in Tech that Benefits Employees
